Legend of Circling Raven

Circling Raven was perhaps the most powerful, spiritual, and prophetic chief of the Coeur d'Alene people. Legend has it that his powerful guardian spirit appeared to him in the form of a raven, who would communicate with him in helping ways. On Montana buffalo hunts the raven would circle and tell the location of nearby herds, warn of approaching enemy tribes, or even foretell the coming of warm winds which would melt the snow, clearing previously blocked mountain passes.

Circling Raven's vision song can sometimes still be heard, in the wind drifting through the trees and floating over the grassy hills, continuing to guide his people in these ever-changing times, with the wisdom of the past. Given Circling Raven's leadership and vision, he is often thought of as a "Founding" Father" of the modern Coeur d'Alene Tribe.

The modern Coeur d'Alene Tribe is the sum of uncounted centuries and of untold generations. In the tribe's own ancient language, it is called Schitsu'umsh, meaning "those who are found here," or "the discovered people." The name, Coeur d'Alene, was given to the tribe by early French fur traders and means "heart of the awl," referring to the sharp trading skills of tribal members.

The Coeur d'Alene people have been in this area for many thousands of years. The original homeland spanned almost 5 million acres, covering what is now North Idaho, Western Montana, and Eastern Washington.

The Coeur d'Alenes are who they always were and who they will always be. The tribe's culture and tradition have survived great changes, but our hearts have never changed. Just as Circling Raven honored those who came before him, we honor his special place in the Coeur d'Alene Tribe and continue to be inspired by his noble leadership.

A 7,189 yard, par 72 championship designed course that is sensitively placed amid 620 rambling acres of lush forested meadows and carefully preserved wetland of the sun-blessed Coeur d'Alene recreation area, Circling Raven was conceived by famed golf course architect Gene Bates to blend with nature. Twisted Earth, son of Circling Raven, received his name after becoming lost during a fishing trip. He and his group had enormous difficulty finding their way home. The group's misfortune brought great humor to the main camp back at home and earned him a new name, S'lpst'ulikhm (Earth got twisted around) or Twisted Earth. It is fitting that Circling Raven's son's unique and colorful name be associate with the be associated with the beautiful course that twists back and forth along with Rose Creek, through timber and over hills, twisted around the earth, and back to the clubhouse that honors his name
